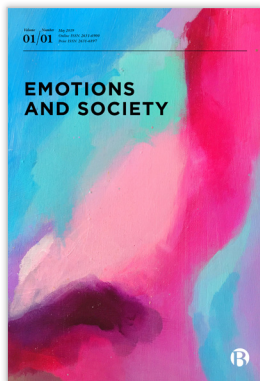


EMOTIONS AND SOCIETY
